Estella's Brilliant Bus and Drake State bring STEAM camp to north Alabama

(HUNTSVILLE, ALA.) The legendary Estella's Brilliant Bus (EBB), supported by Oprah Winfrey and featured on CNN, will be at Drake State Community & Technical College July 11-22 for its STEAM and entrepreneurship summer camp. This unique experience will be open to youth 12 years old to 18. Lunch will be provided to all attendees.

EBB was founded by the late Estella Pyfrom, who decided as a retiree to create a mobile computer classroom to serve children in underprivileged neighborhoods. Ms. Pyfrom's bus began rolling in 2011, and quickly garnered national attention. Camp will start each weekday morning at 9 a.m. and end at 3 p.m.

"It's my honor to keep my mother's dream and legacy alive," said Mia Pyfrom, the director of the summer program. "We are grateful to Drake State for partnering with us in bringing Estella's Brilliant Bus to Huntsville."

EBB students will have access to high-speed WiFi and state-of-the-art computers. They will participate in STEAM educational activities and receive financial literacy training. EBB students also will be able to participate in an upcoming underwater robotics program sponsored by the Smithsonian Institution.
